TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

The following requirements are relevant and apply to all parties exhibiting at the event. By registering for the event, the relevant party agrees to all the terms and conditions required by the event organizer.

1. By registering for the event, the exhibitor, places a legally binding, irrevocable bid to rent a stall at the MOUNTAINBIKE Festival in the timeframe of the 19th to the 22nd September 2024, the stall can be used as an exhibition area as well as a point of sale. Registering with preempted reservations, as well as registering with amendments to the requirements can only be made with clear permission from the event organizers.
2. A written contract, with regard to the rented space, will only be awarded once the exhibitor confirms in writing, that that the space will be taken. Full discretion, with regard to the acceptance or rejection of an offer lies fully with the event organizer. Discretion regarding the placement of stalls lies fully with the event organizer, and will be made taking the full event into consideration.
3. As soon as a written agreement is made, the costs will be calculated using the information given on the registration form, this will be included in the contract and ensuing bills. All funds due, must be paid, within 30 days from the invoice date, into the bank account. Failure to make the required payment within the required timeframe will result in legal action in accordance to the German law.
4. The following cost structure will be applicable upon the cancellation of the contract: Cancellations up to three months before the event are free of charge. For cancellations, up to six weeks before the event, we charge 40% of all the rental as well as additional costs. At any point earlier than six weeks, 100% of all costs will be required. The responsibility of proving less or no damages to the event organizer, due to the cancellation, lies fully on the retracting party.
5. If all payments are not made in due time, the event organizer has the right to revoke the offer and to cancel the agreement.
6. If the event needs to be cancelled due to strikes, political events, or any other significant reason, thus circumstances beyond the control of the event organizer, both parties are released from any other performance. Further damage claim towards the organizer, in particular for direct and indirect consequently damage, financial loss and sales failure etc., are excluded.
7. Special case of pandemic: If the event is cancelled due to official bans, disproportionate requirements or for other reasons related to a pandemic, the above provisions on force majeure shall apply accordingly.
8. The event organizer provides the stand, based on the measurements agreed upon and electricity if requested. The responsibility lies solely on the exhibitor to provide his/her own marketing material and stand outfitting, on top of that, the responsibility for the danger, cost, transportation, construction and dismantling of the marketing material and outfitting will also be carried by the exhibitor. All the relevant information with regard to the dimensions and construction times will be provided to the exhibitor in a timely fashion.
9. The exhibitor is obliged to provide his/her own neat and orderly refuse solution. The event organizer will provide a container at a collection point for all discarded refuse. All refuse is to be brought to the collection point or be provided for pick up as by prior agreement.
10. Liability relating to all offered products, test rides, and sold products to the Festival visitor, falls solely on the exhibitor. The stand operator is responsible for complying with the traffic safety obligation, in particular for set-ups and goods presentations. All required official documentation as well as all official permits (ex. Trade certificate) and the proper taxation of the products falls under the responsibility of the exhibitor.
11. All exhibitors must take the other exhibitors into consideration, so that the operations at the various stands do not get affected in any way whatsoever. Permission for the usage of a sound system must be explicitly granted by the event organizer well in advance.
12. The building will be monitored by a security service, contracted by the event organizer, for the duration of the night. Nevertheless, the exhibitor is still obliged to secure all the products, especially bicycles, against theft, unlawful or unwanted removal by a third party. The event organizer does not take any responsibility and cannot be held liable in any way for the loss or theft of any products. No insurance policy is in place for such an event. The same applies for the exhibitor parking.
13. The event organizer cannot be held liable in any way for damages caused during the event, by products, outfitting or possessions of the exhibitor. This provision is invalid if the damage, loss, injury or loss of life is caused by the event organizer or vicarious agent of the event organizer, through gross negligence or dereliction of duty.
14. The stand operators themselves provide accommodation for their staff.
